

Llandyssil Community Charitable Trust Village Lottery

An invitation to join LCCT Village Lottery

LCCT Committee raises valuable funds every year for the running of Llandyssil Old School Hall (the village hall). Money raised from the Village Lottery will be used to maintain and improve the hall for the benefit of all users as well as subsidising social events held at the hall.

By joining the lottery you can help ensure Llandyssil Village Hall remains open as a resource for all the residents in our community, as well as having a chance to win cash prizes.

Llandyssil Lottery is classed as a private lottery and is open to all residents from Llandyssil village and the surrounding area, their families and friends. When you join, you'll be allocated a Lottery Number – this is not transferrable. Each number has an equal chance of winning.

You need to be aged over 16 to take part.

How it works:

- The annual cost is £10 per number – paid in advance – this is £2.50 per draw
- There will be 4 draws each year - usually at a coffee morning – approximately April, July, October & January
- Prize money will be 30% of the funds allocated that quarter – eg. if 100 players, then available funds for the quarter will be $100 \times £2.50 = £250$. 30% of this fund gives total prize money of £75. This would give winnings of: 1st Prize £40 (53.33% of £75), 2nd Prize £25 (33.33% of £75), 3rd Prize £10 (13.33% of £75)
- You may buy any amount of numbers
- If you join part-way through a year, your entry fee will be pro-rata, ie. £7.50 for the remaining 3 draws
- More numbers sold = bigger prize fund

Llandyssil Lottery Rules

1. The object of the lottery is to raise funds for Llandyssil Old School Hall (the village hall)
2. The lottery will be administered by and run under the supervision of Llandyssil Community Charitable Trust
3. The lottery is open to all residents of Llandyssil and the surrounding area, their family and friends
4. Players must be aged 16 or over
5. Players must complete an application form before being allocated their number(s)
6. Entry shall be £10 per year per number for 4 draws and pro-rata for fewer, paid in advance
7. Players may have more than one number
8. The regular quarterly prize fund will be 30% of the quarterly income – there will be 3 prizes:-
9. 1st Prize = 53.33% of prize fund, 2nd Prize = 33.33% of prize fund, 3rd Prize = 13.33% of prize fund
10. Winners will be contacted personally and announced on village noticeboards, website & newsletter
11. Registers will be kept recording the name & address of each player, the number(s) allocated to them and the subscriptions received
12. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left if their renewal subscription remains unpaid for 3 months
13. If a winner can't be contacted, their winnings will be placed into Llandyssil village hall funds after 6 months
